## COVID-19 guidance for on tour events

## From 9<sup>th</sup> December 2021

- Care for the Family are very aware of the risks around COVID-19 and will always seek to comply with the latest legislation and guidance applicable for the appropriate Nation.
- The guidance does vary between Nations we will always seek to comply with the local guidance for each venue.
- Care for the Family will also comply with restrictions placed upon us by the venues we use.
- The COVID-19 situation, and therefore the legislation and advice, change often and sometimes at short notice.
- The Care for the Family website will be kept up to date with information about each event.
- We will update people who have booked with an email two days before the event to confirm all event details and current requirements.
- If it becomes necessary for us to cancel an event, even at short notice, we will fully refund the cost of your ticket.
- If you show any symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you please not attend the event; if you cannot transfer your ticket to someone else please contact us for a full refund.
- It is possible that some of the practicalities surrounding our events may look a little different due to government advice, such as:
  - Requiring everyone (unless exempt) to wear masks
  - o Checking peoples' COVID-19 passes before allowing entry
  - o Increasing social distancing in the venue
