speaker and author of books including *Long Story Short*. He is married to Jo and they have two young daughters.

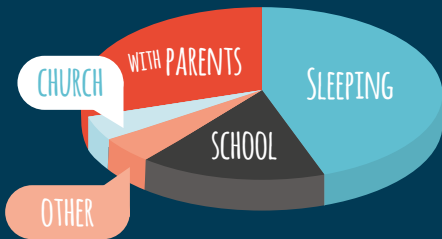
WORSHIP LED BY PETE JAMES
